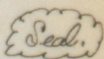


Know all men by these presents, that I
 A. D. Searl of Lawrence City, Kansas Territory
 for and in consideration of the sum of thirty
 dollars, to me in hand paid by Henry W. Fick
 of the same place, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have bargained, sold and by these
 presents do bargain, sell, convey and forever quit-
 claim, to the said Henry W. Fick, all my right
 title and interest, legal and equitable, to the
 following described premises, being in Kansas
 Territory, between Kansas and Kawkasas rivers
 on the dividing ridge north of the California
 road, bounded and described as follows, to wit:
 beginning at the north east corner of G. L.
 Thatchers claim, (transferred to H. J. Burleigh
 and by him to H. A. Bronson) thence north 160 rods
 thence west 160 rods, thence south 160 rods, thence
 east on Bronsons north line 160 rods to the place
 of beginning, together with the appurtenances
 thereto belonging.
