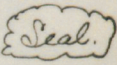


Know all men by these presents, that

 all my right title and interest whatever, legal or
 equitable to the following premises, (to wit) being in
 Kansas Territory, commencing at Jerome B. Gaffs
 south east corner, thence east 160 rods, thence
