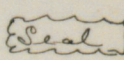


Know all men by these presents, That I

 thirty five Dollars to me in hand paid by Otis
 Potter of Sumner, Kansas, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-
 claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and
 quit claim, unto the said Potter, his heirs, executors, ad-
 ministrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest
 claim and demand in and to the following described
 land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the
 Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A.D.
 Searl, A.D. 1854 - to wit: - Lots number two hundred and
 two and two hundred and four (202 & 204) Tennessee Street.
 And I, William Evans aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by
 these presents, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars,
 to Otis Potter aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators
 to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them
 all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of
 the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person
 or persons whosoever, to any and all of the above
 described property, to have and to hold the same, with all
 the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever,
 In witness whereof, I have herewith set my hand
 and seal the twelfth day of July A.D. 1856 -
