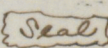

Smith of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Five Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of the Town of Lawrence, Kansas, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand, in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the Survey made by A. D. Searl A. D. 1854 to wit: - lot number ninety five Vermont Street - And I, C. H. Smith aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Seventy Five Dollars, to Henry Campbell aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
