 have bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these Presents  
 do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Jones  
 heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever all  
 my right, title, interest, claim and demand, in and  
 to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town  
 of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the  
 Survey made by A. D. Seal A.D. - 1854 - to wit:-

Lots number one hundred and six (106) Vermont St,  
 number one hundred and seven (107) Vermont St.  
 number one hundred and one (101) Kentucky St.

And I, S. N. Simpson aforesaid, my heirs, executors,  
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by  
 these Presents, in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to R. D.  
 Jones aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and  
 assigns, to well and truly make over and convey to him  
 or them all the title which I shall receive from the  
 Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any  
 power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all  
 of the aforesaid above described property, to have and to  
hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances  
 thereto belonging, forever.
