

Know all men by these presents, That I
 Noah D. Howland of the Town of Lawrence, Territory
 of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of
 Two Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Geo.
 H. Collamore of the city of Boston Mass. The
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained,
 sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and
 quit claim unto the said Collamore his heirs, executors
 administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest
 claim and demand in and to the following described land
 lying and situate in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of
 Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl A.D. 1854,
 to wit:- One undivided half of lot number forty one (41) Massachu-
 setts Street not including the improvements which belong to said
 Howland on said Lot, but said Howland is to remove his house
 within twelve days from this date.

And I Noah D. Howland aforesaid, my heirs, executors
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these
 Presents in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to G. H. Collamore
 aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and
 truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall
 receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any
 power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the
 above described property, to have and to hold the same with all
 the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever -
