

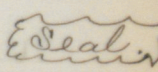
Know all men by these Presents, That I, Henry W. Fick of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and fifty dollars, to me in hand paid by Parnham Roswell and James P. Ellis of the County of Tippecanoe Indiana, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit claimed, and by these Presents do bargain, sell and quit claim, unto the said Roswell & Ellis, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Pearl A.D. - 1854 - to wit: - Lots Sixty Three (63) Kentucky Street and One Hundred and forty (140) and One Hundred and Forty Two (142) Tennessee Street.

And I, Henry W. Fick aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to said Roswell and Ellis aforesaid, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances, thereunto belonging, forever.
