 Number sixty nine (69) Vermont Street -

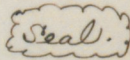
And I Charles Robinson for the above Company

 which we shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of
 Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever,
 to any and all of the above described property, to have and to
 hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging forever.
