D. Pearl, A. D. 1854 as follows, to wit.

And I, Henry Campbell aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars, to J. C. Tierman aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the aforesaid above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privilege and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
