 Town or City of Leavenworth, Kansas, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed
 and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the
 said Heary his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 forever, all my right, title, interest claim and demand, in
 and to the following described land, situate and lying in the
 Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according
 to the survey made by A. D. Seale A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

Lot number Ninety five (95) New Hampshire Street.

Lot number Forty (40) Vermont Street.

Lot number Sixty two (62) Massachusetts Street.

And I, J. A. Bailey aforesaid my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by
 these presents, in the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars
 to C. Heary aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators
 and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto
 him or them all the title which I shall receive from the
 Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power
 or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above
 described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the
 privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
