

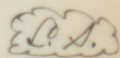
Know all men by these Presents, That I,

 Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Two
 Hundred and Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by
 Henry L. Chapin of Waupun Wisconsin, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and
 quit claimed, and by these Presents do bargain, sell
 and quit claim unto the said Chapin, his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns forever, all my right,
 title interest, claim and demand in and to the following
 described land, situate and lying in the Town of
 Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to
 the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit: —

The south-half of lot number nine (9) Massachusetts street
 And I, S. B. Prentiss aforesaid, his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these
 Presents in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to Henry L. Chapin
 aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them
 all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees
 of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power,
 or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of
 the above described property, to Have and to Hold the
 same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
