L. + J. S. Jones, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit: -

Lot number Eighty nine (89) on Vermont Street, And I, Samuel Bryson aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to Reason L. Jones and John S. Jones aforesaid, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
