McClelland of the City of Leavenworth, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said John A. McClelland his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854. to-wit: Chare No. 184 Comprising the following lots, to-wit: Lot No. 33 on Ohio Street. Lot 93 on Kentucky Street. Lot No. 76 on Ohio Street. Lot No. 104 on New York Street. Lot No. 54 on Rhode Island Street. Lot No. 100 on Connecticut Street. Lot No. 47 on Pinkney Street. Lot No. 10 on New Jersey Street. Lot No. 146 on Tennessee Street. Lots No. 28 and 30 on Pennsylvania Street.

And the said A. Whitney aforesaid, his heirs, executors administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Five hundred dollars, to John A. McClelland aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
