 in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to me in hand
 paid by Edward Chapman, of the Town and Territory aforesaid, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these
 Presents does bargain, sell, and quit-claim, unto the said Edward Chapman
 his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title,
 interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land,
 situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according
 to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -
 Lot number sixty seven (67) on Vermont Street, and lot number sixty
 two (62) on Vermont Street, and lot number Seventy (70) Vermont Street,
 and lot number thirty two (32) New Hampshire Street, and lot number
 thirty (30) Pinkney Street, and lot number sixteen (16) on Pinkney Street, and
 lot number twenty six (26) on Kentucky Street, and lot number one (1) on
 Massachusetts Street.

And I, John P. Hood aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators
 and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum
 of One Thousand Dollars, to Edward Chapman aforesaid, his heirs,
 executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make
 over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from
 the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or
 person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property,
 to Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurte-
 nances therein to belonging forever.
