

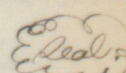
Know all Men by these Presents, that I, William Evans, near the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars, to me in hand paid by Otis Potter of the Town of Sumner near Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim, unto the said Otis Potter, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seal, A.D. 1854, to-wit: - Two lots on Pennsylvania St. numbers eighty-nine (89) and forty-two (42) and one lot on New Hampshire St. numbers one hundred and eighty-four (184).

And I, William Evans aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to Otis Potter aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
