


Know all Men by these Presents, That I

 receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence,  
 or from any power or person or persons whomsoever,  
 to any and all of the above described property, to have  
 and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurte-  
 nances thereunto belonging, forever.
