

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Henry Campbell, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars, to me in hand paid by Franc Zsimnovzky of above place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these Presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Franc Zsimnovzky, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:—

Lot No. One Hundred and fifty (150) Rhode Island St. And I, Henry Campbell aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to said Franc Zsimnovzky aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances, therunto belonging forever.
