

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Samuel Merrill, of the Town of Lawrence, State or Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Dollars, to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these Presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim, unto the said Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:

Lot number ninety three (93) Connecticut Street. And I, Samuel Merrill aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum of Fifty Dollars to Henry Campbell aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
