Pennsylvania, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit ^{claimed} and by these Presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Robert S. Brown, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the Survey made by A.D. Searl, A.D. 1854, to wit:- Lot number three (3) Lever street and lot No. Ninety three (93) Connecticut street.-

And I Henry Campbell aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum of Two hundred and Twenty Dollars, to Robert S. Brown M.D. aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
