

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John C. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and Edward Winslow party of the second part, Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees, and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by said Edward Winslow, of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quit claimed, and by these Presents do convey, release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart of said Town as surveyed by W. D. Searl, A. D. 1854 as follows, to-wit:-

Share number One Hundred twenty one (121), containing lots as follows. Pinkney Street, twenty five (25) Kentucky Street Eighty one (81) - Rhode Island Street, Seventy seven (77) Louisiana Street, two hundred twenty seven (227) Pennsylvania Street - Seventy (70) New York Street one hundred forty (140) Indiana Street, two hundred twenty five (225) N. Hampshire Street, one hundred seventy four (174) Delaware Street one hundred one (101) and one hundred three (103) - Indiana Street one hundred twenty two (122) - and lot Kentucky Street eight (8) To have and to hold the aforesaid quit claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming
