D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: - Lots numbered eleven (11) Fifty nine (59) One hundred forty one (141) One hundred and six (106) and one hundred and eight (108) on Term. Street. And one hundred and thirty four (134) and two hundred and fifteen (215) and two hundred and ninety nine (299) on Miss. Street. One (1) Thirty seven (37) and one hundred and forty ⁽¹⁴⁰⁾ on Del. Street. Eighty seven (87) and one hundred and sixty nine (169) on Kentucky Street. One hundred and five (105) and one hundred and eighty (180) on New Hampshire Street. One hundred and forty five (145) and one hundred and seventy (170) on New York Street. Sixty one (61) on Vermont Street. Twenty two (22) on Ohio Street. Two hundred and thirty nine (239) on Louisiana Street. Two hundred and thirty three (233) on Indiana Street. One hundred and twenty one (121) on Rhode Island Street.
