D. Seal, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lots No. sixty five (65) and sixty six (66) Rhode Island St. And I, Henry Campbell aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to said Saml. S. Dugren, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the aforesaid above described property, To Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever,
