Weir his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lots No. one hundred and fourteen (114) Ky. St. One Hundred and Sixty four (164) Tenn. St. One Hundred and six, and One Hundred and twelve (106-112) La. St. And I, Turner Sampson, of the Town of Lawrence and Territory aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five hundred Dollars to D. H. —

Weir — aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title & which I shall receive from the Trustees of said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have and To Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
