Keir, of Nebraska City N. T. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and do by these presents do bargain sell and quit-claim unto the said, D. H. Keir - his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seab, A. D. 1854, to-wit: Lot No. One Hundred and eighty-seven (187) Town. St. And I, Henry Campbell of the Town of Lawrence and Territory aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns <sup>by these presents</sup> to-wit, are held and firmly bound, in the sum of one hundred dollars to said D. H. Keir, - aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to-wit and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
