Swope, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:

Lot number One hundred and forty seven (147) Tennessee St. And I, C. A. Wright aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held, and jointly bound by these presents in the sum of forty Dollars, to said William C. Swope aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whosoever, to any and all of the above described property.
