


Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Turner Sampson

 of Danville Ky. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 have bargained, sold, and quit claimed and do
 by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the
 said Thomas A. Swope, his heirs, executors, administrators,
 and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest,
 claim and demand in and to the following de-
 scribed land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence,
 in the state of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D.
 Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: - Lots No. Seventy four (74) Rhode
 Island St. One hundred twenty seven (127) Kentucky St.
 One hundred and thirty two (132) One hundred and Thirty-four
 (134) Tennessee St. One hundred and fourteen (114) Ohio St.

And I, Turner Sampson aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
 by these presents in the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty
 dollars to said Thomas A. Swope aforesaid, his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over
 and convey unto him or them all the title which I
 shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence
 or from any power or person or persons, whosoever, to
 any and all of the above described property, To Have and To
 Hold the same with all the Privileges and appurtenances
 therunto belonging, forever. In witness whereof, I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st day of November, A.D.
 1854.
