Swope, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: - Lots No. Seventy four (74) Rhode Island St. One hundred twenty seven (127) Kentucky St. One hundred and thirty two (132) One hundred and thirty four (134) Tennessee St. One hundred and fourteen (114) Ohio St.

And I, Turner Sampson aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty dollars to said Thomas H. Swope aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons, whosoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the Privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
