Swope, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lot number two hundred and forty nine (249) Louisiana St. And I, John Mack aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Thirty dollars, to said William C. Swope, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property.
