 sideration of the sum of two hundred and ten dollars,
 to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell, of aforesaid
 place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
 bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents do
 bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Henry
 Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,
 forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and
 to the following described land, situate and lying in the
 Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey
 made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: Lot No. Eighty five (85)
 Eighty seven (87) Ohio Street. One hundred and twenty seven (127)
 One hundred and twenty nine (129) Tennessee Street.
 And I, John Speer, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, admin-
 istrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these
 presents in the sum of Four hundred and Twenty dollars,
 to said Henry Campbell, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, ad-
 ministrators and assigns, to well and truly make over
 and convey unto him or them all the title which I
 shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of
 Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whom-
 soever, to any and all of the above described property,
 To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges
 and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
