 to-wit:- Lot number forty six (46) Connecticut Street.
 And I, William Pellet, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound
 by these Presents, in the sum of Seventy Dollars, to said Thos.
 B. Sykes, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and
 assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto
 him or them all the title which I shall receive from
 the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power,
 or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above
 described property. To Have and to Hold the same
