

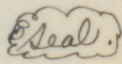

Sykes, of Leavenworth K. T. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these Presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim, unto the said Thos. B. Sykes, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:—

Lot number Fifty Four (54) New Jersey St.

And I, Ferdinand Fuller, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these Presents, in the sum of Thirty Dollars, to said Thos. B. Sykes aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any or all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances, thereunto belonging, forever.
