 acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these  
 presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said T. L. Smith & Silas  
 Green, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my  
 right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following  
 described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the  
 Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl,  
 A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

 ces thereto belonging, forever.
