 unto the said Jenkin W. Morris, his heirs, executors, administra-
 tors and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and
 demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in
 the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according
 to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:

Lot No. One hundred and seven (107) Kentucky Street.
 And I, Chas. Robinson, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound unto
 the said Jenkin W. Morris, aforesaid, his heirs,
 executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make
 over and convey unto him or them all the title which
 I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of
 Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons, whom
 soever, to any and all of the above described property,
 To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges
 and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
