 forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to
 the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of
 Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the
 survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

Lot No. Sixty five (65) Massachusetts Street,
 And I, C. A. Wright, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 are held and firmly bound by these presents
 in the sum of four hundred dollars to said Henry
 Brown aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and
 assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto
 him or them all the title which I shall receive from
 the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any
 power, or person or persons whomever, to any and all of
 the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same
 with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging
 forever.
