L. Whitney of the said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents, do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Hill & Whitney, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

Lot nineteen (19) Lot twenty one (21) Park Lot twenty four (24) Rhode Island St. and Lot twenty seven (27) N. W. St. And I Solomon Wildes aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Four hundred dollars to Hiram Hill and J. L. Whitney, aforesaid, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whosoever to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
