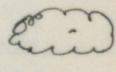


Know all Men by these Presents, That S. Y. Lum of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Five Dollars to me in hand paid by the Trustees of the American Unitarian Association for the erection of a Church Building in Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit-claim unto the said Association, their executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lot one hundred & twenty nine (129) on Ohio Street. And I the said S. Y. Lum, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One hundred dollars to the said Trustees aforesaid, their executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whosoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever,
