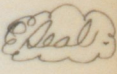

Lungren, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, lying and situate in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas according to the survey made by A. D. Karl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: Lot No. One hundred and twenty four (124) - One hundred and twenty six (126) Ohio Street.

And I, A. B. Wade, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two hundred Dollars to said Saml. S. Lungren, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whatsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances, thereto belonging, forever.
