

Know all Men by these Presents, that I Henry Williams of the Town of Lawrence, State of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of aforesaid place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Henry Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lot No. Twenty four (24) Ohio Street.

And I Henry Williams, aforesaid; my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One hundred dollars, to said Henry Campbell, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to ^{well and truly} make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all the above described property, To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
