 ever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to
 the following described land, situate and lying in the City of
 Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made
 by A. D. Searl, A.D. 1854, to-wit:-

One Lot number "thirty one" on Massachusetts street,
 according to said Plot of A. D. Searl.

And I, S. C. Pomeroy, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, ad-
 ministrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by
 these presents in the sum of Fourteen hundred dollars to said
 Duncan & Miller aforesaid, their heirs, executors, adminis-
 trators and assigns, to well and truly make over and con-
 vey unto them all the title which I shall receive from
 the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence, or from any person
 or persons whomsoever, to and and all of the above described
 property. To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges
 and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
