Wright aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property; To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto ^{forever} belonging.
