Frazer, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seal, A. D. 1854, to-wit: Lot No. one hundred and twenty seven (127) and one hundred and twenty nine (129) Tennessee Street.

And I, Henry Campbell, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of three hundred dollars to said Robert L. Frazer, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or ^{person} or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
