 C. A. Wright of the Town of Lawrence, the receipt whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold & quit claimed and by  
 these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Wright  
 his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my  
 right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following  
 described land, situate and lying in the Town of  
 Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey  
 made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

Lot number sixteen Rhode Island (16) street.  
 & fifty six (56) New Hampshire Street.

And I, Thos. F. Reynolds, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,  
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by  
 these presents in the sum of sixty six dollars to C. A.  
 Wright aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators  
 assigns to well & truly make over & convey unto him or  
 them all the title which I shall receive from the  
 Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power  
 or person or persons whomsoever, to all of the above described  
 property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges  
 & appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
