Know all men by these Presents, that I, Jacob Bollman, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Egger of Franklin K.S., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Henry Egger, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A.D. Searl, A.D. 1854, to-wit: Lot No. Seventy one (71) New Hampshire Street.

And I, Jacob Bollman, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred dollars to said Henry Egger, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of December, A.D. 1856.
