 interest, claim and demand in and to the following
 described land, situate and lying in the Town of
 Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the
 survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-
 Lots No. Seventy eighth (78) Eighty (80) and eighty two
 (82) Kentucky Street.

And I, Owen A. Bassett, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound
 by these presents in the sum of five hundred dollars to
 said Thos. H. Swope, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators,
 and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto
 him or them all the title which I shall receive from the ^{Trustees}
 of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person
 or persons whosoever, to any and all of the above described
 property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the
 privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever,
