

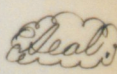

Wright, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Hiram Appleman of Lawrence K. T., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Hiram Appleman, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

The south half of Lot No. Four (4) Massachusetts ^{street}.
And I, C. A. Wright, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five hundred dollars to said Hiram Appleman aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them, all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
