

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Henry Campbell, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars to me in hand paid by John C. Douglass of Leavenworth City, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said John C. Douglas, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lot No. Forty (40) New Jersey Street, and one hundred and seven (107) and one hundred and nine (109) Delaware Street.

And I, Henry Campbell, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred dollars to said John C. Douglass, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them, all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
