

Wright, of the County of Douglas, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents, do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said C. A. Wright, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claims, and demands, in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searls, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-
 Lot numbering nine (9) on Pinkney Street in the town of Lawrence K. T.

And I, Jno. P. Hood, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred dollars to C. A. Wright, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, ^{to enjoy and all of the above described property} to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
