

This Indenture made and entered into this seventeenth-day of October, One Thousand eight hundred and fifty five
Between Horace A. Hancock, of the Town of Lawrence and
Territory of Kansas, party of the first part and S.P. Temple
of the same place, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said Hancock, Party of the first Part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed hath bargained, sold, quit claimed, transferred and set over and by these presents does bargain, sell, quit claim, transfer and set over unto the said Temple, party of the second part all my right, title, and interest, in and to the following land and premises and the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, viz: That certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Lawrence, aforesaid, on the west side of Louisiana Street, bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake on the west side of Louisiana Street and running thence due west one hundred and seventeen (117) feet, thence south fifty (50) feet, thence east one hundred and seventeen (117) feet, thence north along said street fifty (50) feet to the place of beginning, said piece of land being designated on a map drawn by A.D. Searl as lot number one hundred and nine (109) Louisiana Street. Also that other piece or parcel of land situate in the Town of Lawrence, known and bounded as follows. Beginning at a stake on the west side of Kentucky Street, running thence west one hundred and seventeen (117) feet, thence south fifty (50) feet, thence east one hundred and seventeen (117) feet, thence north along said street fifty (50) feet, to the place of beginning, said piece of land being known as lot No one hundred and thirty one (131) Kentucky Street on the map aforesaid.
