Reese, of the City of Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Saml. L. Reese, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: - Lot No. Two Hundred & Twenty five on Indiana Street, And I, Edward Winslow, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred dollars, to said Samuel L. Reese, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence, or from any person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
