

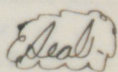
Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Robert Morrow, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, to me in hand paid by Josiah Miller, of the same place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Josiah Miller, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claims and demand in and to the following described land, situate and ^{lying} in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: -

Lot ninety six (96) Kentucky Street.

And I Robert Morrow, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred dollars, to said Josiah Miller aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the Privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
